Anchor 1: Oh, what's that?? (поднимает с пола шкатулку с надписью **Magic Box**)

Anchor 2: I don't know! Let's see! (читают вместе в зал): **MAGIC BOX!**

Anchor 1: Wow! It's so wonderful! I always dreamt of finding something like that!
Let's say a wish and see, if it works!

Anchor 2 (ironically): I even know what your wish may be! You are fond of travelling! Am I right?

Anchor 1: Yes! I'd like to visit some foreign countries! For example, America!

(на экране - флаг США)

(Sting's song)

Anchor 1: What a nice magic box! You can get anywhere!

Anchor 2: As for me, I don't want to live anywhere but in my native place! It's my Daghestan!

Anchor 1: Oh, no! It's so boring here! (открывает шкатулку и загадывает желание): I want to go to England!

(на экране - символы Англии)

(English song)

Anchor 1: Show us a modern dance! How do young people in England dance nowadays?

(modern dance)

Anchor 2: Well, it really works! But I think that our dances are better!

(открывает шкатулку): Now I'd like to see Caucasian dance!

(на экране - кавказские горы)

(парная «Лезгинка»)

Anchor 1: Very nice, indeed! I'm so happy we've found this magic box! Still I want to visit some far-away country and see some traditions of other peoples! Look! (открывает шкатулку): It's again English-speaking country and they are celebrating Christmas!

(сценка Christmas shopping)

(декорации и атрибутика Рождества)

Музыка **Jingle bells**

(двое ребят, фея, продавец)

Первый: To people all over the world, Christmas is a season of giving and receiving presents. Let's follow this tradition, too! I believe that Santa enters down the chimney and leaves candy and presents inside the socks for us (указывает на камин с красными носками).

Первый: Oh, Fairy, please help us! We need to do a good thing before Christmas comes.

Fairy: Then you should be in a hurry. All people now are on Christmas shopping. Let's go there and see.

(появляется продавец с торбой)

Seller: Decorations! Decorations! Have you bought decorations for your Christmas tree yet?

Первый: Oh, it's good that you reminded me about it. Give me three colorful decorations, please (ищет кошелек в карманах).

Seller протягивает ему гирлянды.

Первый: Somebody has stolen my money! What shall I do now?

(Seller уходит)

Fairy: I can't help you, all my magic has finished!

Второй: Oh, it does not matter! I can share my decorations with you! I have enough for us both (достаёт из сумки гирлянды и отдаёт их первому).

Первый: Thank you very much, friend!

Fairy (дотрагиваясь волшебной палочкой до него): And I suppose, Santa will be pleased by you! You will get his present as well.
